In addition to its music lineup, Epiphany will also present the traveling photo exhibition "Women of the Blues: A Coast-To-Coast Collection," curated by Lynn Orman Weiss in partnership with Epiphany Center for the Arts. The collection of images from photographers around the country celebrates female blues performers past and present, and features some of this year's artists performing at the Chicago Blues Festival, including Shemekia Copeland, Annika Chambers, Thornetta Davis, Anne Harris, Shirley Johnson, Demetria Taylor, Ivy Ford and Legendary Mary Lane. The exhibit also features blues women performing during Epiphany's Blues Music Series, including Carlise Guy, Brigitte Purdy and Win Noll.

"Women of the Blues" is scheduled to run from June 8 through July 23, 2022 in the gallery space outside The Sanctuary.
